116.01 JURISDICTION. The Clarion Municipal Airport shall at all times be under the jurisdiction of the Council.

116.02 RULES AND REGULATIONS. The Council may, by resolution, prescribe rules and regulations for the conduct and operation of such airport, which rules and regulations shall be effective by posting in a conspicuous place upon the grounds and at the hangar thereon.

116.03 SCHEDULE OF CHARGES. The Council may from time to time establish and collect a schedule of charges for the use of such airport or any part thereof, which charges shall be used in connection with the maintenance and operation of the airport.

116.04 MANAGER. The Assistant Public Works Director shall serve as manager to operate and maintain the airport. The Council may employ such other help which may be needed for the operation and maintenance thereof.

116.05 REPORTS BY MANAGER. The manager shall make a full and complete report to the Council at the first regular meeting each quarter as to the condition of the airport and all property and equipment thereon belonging to the City and shall also make an itemized report of the receipts and disbursements.

116.06 AIRPORT FUND. All funds derived from the operation of the airport shall be reported to the Clerk and paid by the Clerk to the Treasurer and the same shall be kept in a separate fund which shall be expended only for the maintenance and operation of the airport and for the payment of interest and bonds outstanding for the purchase and equipping thereof.

116.07 EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION. The compensation of the manager of the airport and other employees shall set by the Council from time to time by resolution.

116.08 VEHICLE PARKING. All vehicles shall be parked upon the driveways and the streets and highways adjacent to the airport in accordance with the rules and regulations established by resolution of the Council, and posted on the airport grounds and hangar.

116.09 DAMAGING AIRPORT. It is unlawful for any person to injure or destroy any property located upon the Clarion Municipal Airport premises, or to loiter thereon or to drive or park any vehicle upon the field or runways thereof without special permission of the Council, or to violate any rule or regulation of the Council pertaining to such airport, or any rule or regulation of the Iowa State Utilities Board, or the United States Department of Commerce or other departments of the Federal government having supervision of air navigation.
